LIBRARY

The library has books related to all the subjects. Apart from these, there are also enough books on literary, social and religious subjects. Their total number is more than 10 thousand. Trained librarians are appointed to run the library. According to the class level, a 'kit box library' has been created for different classes with biographies of great men, picture stories and some selected books related to self-development. Students use it for intellectual development in their spare time. A separate 'book bank' has been opened in the library for JEE and NEET. These books are also made available to the students.

Many daily newspapers, weekly, fortnightly and monthly newspapers and magazines in Hindi, Sanskrit and English are brought to the reading hall. These are studied in the reading hall as per convenience. These mainly include Dainik Tribune, Rashtradharma, DainikBhaskar, Hari-Bhoomi, Amar Ujala, AkhandJyoti, Cricket Samrat, Competition Darpan, VigyanPragati, Computer Sanchar, ItihasDarpan, Devputra, India Today, Panchjanya, G.K., Science Reporter, The Tribune, Sports Star, VigyanPragati, Samayiki etc.

BUILDING

SMB Gita Senior Secondary School is situated on a huge piece of land in Kurukshetra and Lajpat hostel is functioning in it alongwith its two blocks. There are many lush green flower gardens and a huge playground. At various places, pictorial boards of great men constantly remind us of our goal. All the study rooms equipped with the latest equipment are airy and well-lit. Their names have been kept on the basis of provinces, ideal great men and religious texts. Each house has been decorated in accordance with its name.



COMPUTER LAB

The school has a well established computer lab. In which there are 40 computers and computer subject has been made mandatory for all students. Teaching takes place through projector method in computer laboratory. Students are made aware of new technologies through the Internet.





LABORATORIES

The school has well equipped laboratories for Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Computer Science and Mathematics subjects with modern equipment and there is also a separate science laboratory for classes 6th to 10th. All types of necessary chemicals, charts, models, slides are kept in these laboratories. All the facilities for the better use of these labs are available at every table.

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE RULES

90% attendance is compulsory for every student to appear in the annual examination.

Attendance of all students and teachers in the morning prayer meeting is mandatory.

If a student remains absent for 3 consecutive days without prior information, his/her name is struck off from the school register.

It is necessary to participate in programmes, extra-curricular activities, extra-curricular classes and sports organized in the school.

Applications for leave are accepted only after the recommendation of the parents and the approval of the Principal. To take leave for a period of more than two days, the parent has to submit the application form himself.



STUDENT DIARY

All students are given a diary by the school and it is mandatory to bring it to school every day. All kinds of study-related details are recorded in it. Diary proves helpful in character development and discipline of students. Details in the diary evaluate the entire personality of the child. Parents should check it regularly. It is necessary to show the diary when asked for, otherwise disciplinary action can be taken.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Such talented students who are unable to study due to financial stringency are provided scholarships and free education, books and study material etc. by the school. In limited numbers, highly intelligent but economically backward students are also provided free accommodation and food facilities.



EDUCATIONAL TOURS

Educational Tour has a special importance in our education system. By visiting places of religious and historical importance and great men, one gains knowledge of culture These feelings are felt in the hearts of children. Through these trips children learn many things from their experiences. Every year these trips are organized by the school. According to the department, they are separate as well as collective. A team of 100 students visited Chhatbir Zoo last year.

Students should contact their class incharge before buying the uniform.

- 1. The above mentioned uniforms can be purchased from the shops after informing them.
- 2. On Wednesday and Saturday it is mandatory to wear white pants, white shirt, white socks and black shoes with black laces.
- 3. On the remaining days, it is mandatory for the student to wear the above mentioned uniform prescribed by the school.
- 4. If the student does not wear the prescribed uniform, action will be taken against him as per rules.
- 5. Narrow bottom pants are not allowed.
- 6. Hair should be well-arranged.

HOSTEL

Lajpat Hostel

Hostel life is exciting. It opens the doors of knowledge and science to the hidden talents of the student. This develops the educational, physical, intellectual, mental, vital and spiritual powers of the student. By living in a hostel, the student develops fundamental qualities like humility, good character, courage, self-respect, achievement of goals, patriotism, duty-fulfillment, kindness, love, service and goodwill. If we want to curb the fall in values, tradition and ideas, we must provide them opportunities to spend some time in hostel where all such values are inculcated in students.

All the hostel rooms are fitted with air conditioners. The hostel premises have a neat and clean environment. By staying here, the students stay away from external evils and develop their personality in all aspects. The hostel has accommodation for students from class VI to XII.







Admission Procedure

Admission in class 6th, 9th and 11th is given on the basis of performance of previous class, entrance test marks and interview.

Necessary instructions

Students who qualify the entrance test will be assured of admission through counselling

It will be mandatory for the passed student to submit his/her School Leaving Certificate, Report Card, Birth Certificate and Parent's Aadhar Card along with his/her Aadhar Card.

It is essential that the student is completely healthy. For this, the student must submit his/her medical certificate.



HOSTEL FEE & OTHER CHARGES

The annual fee of the hostel is ₹ 1,25000/-. Which will be payable in the following three installments.

Amount payable at the time of admission (1st instalment) Rs. 42000/-

From 1st to 10th September (second installment) Rs. 42000/-

1st to 10th December (3rd installment) Rs. 41000/-

Deposit hostel fee by the above mentioned dates otherwise a late fee of ₹1000/- per month will be charged.

♦ 5% Concession will be given on one time full fee payment.

Pay special attention:

- 1. If a student is removed or expelled during the academic session for any reason, then no fee will be refunded.
- 2. The hostel holidays are arranged separately. Residential students will not be allowed to go home in case of a school holiday.

Hostel Rules

- Disciplinary action will be taken against the student if he/she leaves the hostel premises or goes home without permission.
- A maximum of three days leave can be granted for the marriage of a real brother or sister. Be sure to attach the card of the marriage taking place in the family with the application.
- There is no provision for such leave on examination, annual function and camp
 days.Pre-approved leave may be given for essential work such as treatment of
 one's own child or illness of other member of one's own family.
- 4. If a student remains absent without prior notice after the expiry of the approved leave, a fine of Rs. 100/- per day will be payable. Information regarding absence from the hostel should reach on the eve of the expiry date of leave. Leave can be granted if the student is unwell. A medical certificate of unwellness will have to be submitted.
- Parents will not be allowed to meet students during school hours on working days. Students can be contacted over phone only on the second Sunday. Parents can meet their children in the hostel only on the last Sunday of the month with the permission of the Chief Warden.
- In view of security, the student may be sent on leave only with a person predecided by theguardian/parent.
- Parents can contact the hostel supervisor to resolve student's problems. Tel -Hostel 8572867027
- 8. Students can be contacted over phone only on Sundays.
- The right to change the rules and regulations is reserved with the school management committee. In case of any legal dispute, the jurisdiction will be Kurukshetra (Haryana).
- 10. Kindly abide by the rules of the hostel.

MEDICAL AID

There is a provision of first aid in the hostel itself. If required, services of experienced doctors are also taken. The hostel bears only the expenses of primary and initial medical treatment. Other medical expenses have to be borne by the guardians.



EXTRA CLASSES

To speed up the educational progress of the hostel students, special classes (Tution) are arranged in the hostel according to the subject of each class. For this, the students have to pay separate fee. These classes are conducted by experienced teachers.



ACCOMMODATION (ROOM)

All the rooms are fully air conditioned and equipped with all facilities. Each room has adequate accommodation for four/five students. Bedsheet, cupboard/rack, chair, table etc. are available for each student. 2 sheets and pillow covers will be provided by the hostel. The school also has a generator set for uninterrupted supply of electricity.



LIBRARY

A library has also been arranged in the hostel which has a vast collection of motivational literature, biographies of great men, important magazines and religious texts. There is also a provision for books related to competitive exams. But these are used during holidays or on the occasions of competitions.



REFUND

After admission, if a child leaves the hostel for any reason or is expelled, then in that case no fee will be refunded.



ROUTINE

For the all-round development of a student, it is necessary to make proper use of time. For this, there is a systematic routine in the hostel. The routine is determined according to the season and every student has to follow it.

Excursion (TOURS)

Every year arrangements are made for the resident students to visit various places for the country tour. Through these tours, enthusiasm, patriotism, spiritual development and geographical knowledge increases in the students. In the same sequence, last year a group of 50 students alongwith hostel workers went on a tour to Rajasthan, Mathura and Vrindavan.

Entertainment

Alongwith the regular routine, there is arrangement to show patriotic and other cultural programmes to the students on television as per the availabilety of time.

CONTACT WITH PARENTS

Detailed information related to all the activities of the child is sent to the parents from time to time by post or phone. This contains complete information about studies, health, conduct, behaviour etc. It is the duty of the parents to pay attention to this information and alert the child and reply to it. Parents can also be called if required.

MESS

The mess is run on a co-operative basis. Pure, vegetarian, tasty and nutritious food is served here.

SPIRITUAL DEVELOPMENT

To develop the students mentally and spiritually, it is compulsory to do yoga, morning prayer, chanting mantra before meals and doing Sandhya. Apart from this, from time to time the Principal, Acharya and enlightened people of the society address the children on moral topics. When religious and social festivals are celebrated, it is compulsory to participate in them. In these programmes, the students have to come in the prescribed dress of white kurta pajama.

Special Warning

"Jewellery, transistors, cameras, walkman, sim cards, MP3, MP4, mobile phones, laptops and unwanted literature are not allowed in the hostel. If found, the student will be expelled from the hostel.

EXPULSION OF STUDENTS

Any boarder is expelled from the hostel due to the following reason(s).

Unethical conduct or indecent behavior. For indiscipline or disorder. When there is no harmony in the hostel routine. If the fees are not deposited on time. By smoking and consuming narcotics. For causing damage to the property of the school or hostel. If one leaves the hostel without obtaining permission. When academic progress is unsatisfactory. If mobile and objectionable material is found.
